Guest attendees: We had no new guests for this meeting.

Mark Novak gave his treasures report. We have \$ 68,902.67 in the club account. And as a reminder, we may need to pay most of this money back to Skydive when we sign a new lease in 2021.

Mike Sandlin gave his membership report. We have 50 paid members in our club.

Larry Faast said he spoke with **Bram** (the owner of Skydive) and it appears we will ne able to sign a fireyear sub-lease in May 2021. The sub-lease will be Skydive. The primary lease will be between Skydive and the City of San Diego. The details of this sub-lease have not been discussed in detail. However, one downside is that **Bram** wants to take much of our hanger space. In exchange he will build some standard metal hangers and a clubhouse.

The newly hired safety officer at Skydive, **Rich May**, quit. No new safety officer has been hired yet.

Club officer elections are coming in December. All previous club officers were nominated by unanimous vote. Since we did not have a quorum, **Jodi Morgan** voted several times to make a quorum. **Robin McGrew** will continue to be our safety officer.
